Plan of Studies

The curriculum is divided into three Summer Residencies at the EGS Saas-Fee campus and continuous training with internships at local sites. There are three Intensive Training Seminars (ITC-P, ITC-D and IT-3) offered on campus in two session periods during the summer in Switzerland.

In the interim periods (fall, winter and spring), students undertake their academic projects and internships, and participate in seminars for Expressive Arts Modules K, P, and F which are either offered by EGS on campus in Saas-Fee or by accredited Cooperating Institutes with approved teachers, training therapists and supervisors.

A minimum of one year is necessary to complete the Master's Thesis requirement.
